






















CARE AND USE OF YOUR TABLE

1. Use spray furniture polish to clean all exterior surfaces of your game table.
2. Use only a suitable 120v AC household outlet.
3. This product is intended for INDOOR use only.
4. **DO NOT** sit, climb or lean on the table.
5. **DO NOT** drag the table when moving it. This will damage the leg.
6. The fan should be unplugged before cleaning and servicing.

Step 1

Attach both end panels #2 to one side panel #1 using the 2" bolts #16 and " washers #17. Be sure the rod holes in the side panel are closest to the floor during this step. Place the rod washers #12 and sponge rings #13 on both ends of each player rod (the washer goes on the inside next to the player). Slide player rods #34 through #39 into the side panel in the exact configuration shown in diagram. Be sure the small hole at the end of the red player rods #37, #38, and #39 is through the side panel. The small hole at the end of the blue player rods #34, #35, and #36 should be furthest away from the side panel.
